IMPORTANT NOTICE



Effective November 1, 2012

Passengers will no longer be able to obtain a free fare voucher or ride from the NTS bus driver.

As of November 1st, passengers needing help with the cost of a ride will need to get a *Bus Fare Pass* for each ride before boarding the bus.

Drivers will collect a bus fare pass or exact cash fare from each passenger. The only exceptions - medically necessary personal care attendants and children under age 5 still may ride for free & without a pass.
